# Warren Oak

Warren Oak Scout Campsite is a 14 acre site, owned and managed by the Malverns District Scouts since 1997, located at the foot of the Malvern Hills in a village called Staplow, around 3 miles NNW of the Historical town of Ledbury. Access to the site is good.

## Accommodation

The accommodation is a main hall with two separate rooms. The provided moveable screens allow flexible partitioning. There is floor space for about 30 - 35 people. There are no beds or mattresses; groups will need to bring their own. All rooms have Oil-fired Central Heating and are carpeted. Trestle tables, forms and chairs are provided.



## Cooking

A modern kitchen is installed with hob units, oven, fridge, twin sink unit and a comprehensive range of cooking utensils. Limited crockery and cutlery are provided.

## Camping

Maximum number of campers catered for approximately 600 in a large open area, split by hedging.

## Costs

£60 for a complete 24 hour period, otherwise £15.00 for a 6-hour period or part thereof, plus the overall camping charge for the site of £1.80 per person per night.

This charge is inclusive of electricity, etc. but users are asked to be as economical as possible with heating, lighting, water, etc.
